

CRIS CANCER FOUNDATION RESEARCH & PROJECTS

CRIS Cancer Foundation is an independent non-profit organisation dedicated to the promotion and development of

research to eliminate cancer.

CRIS Cancer Foundation is currently funding: Four paediatric research projects. These are:

- 1. Natural Killer Cell Therapy in Children with cancer.
- 2. The Lydia Project An innovative clinical trial for children with acute leukaemia without alternative treatment options.
- 3. Ewing Sarcoma Project researching cases in infants. 4. MLL (Mixed Lineage Leukaemia) Project
- 5. Children with Brain Tumours Project
- 6. Paediatric Oncology Unit La Paz

Five adult research projects. These are:

- 1. Translational Haematological Unit.
- 2. Breast cancer drug resistance exploration project.
- 3. Support Line Prostate cancer research for new treatments. 4. Pancreatic Avatar research project.
- 5. Multiple Myeloma Project.
- 6. Ovarian Cancer.

8 research grants financed 100% by CRIS for scientists in the world recognised oncology research hospitals as Royal Marsden Hospital (London, UK), Dana Faber Cancer Institute (US) Harvard Center (US), Institute of Cancer Research (London, UK) among others. The above projects are currently underway, driven by a strong scientific committee and a great alliance with some of the leading oncological institutions in Spain and the UK.

EVENT INFORMATION

The annual Gala Dinner is in its sixth year and is a proven major fundraising event for CRIS Cancer Foundation. Last year the ball was an outstanding success with all tickets sold out and 359 seated guests. The evening itself had a wonderful atmosphere and the Silent Auction, with bids made on the iBid System (using electronic bidding on a tablet similar to a tablet) was very successful.

OPEN CALL FOR ARTISTS

CRIS Cancer Foundation is pleased to announce an Open Call for its 6th CRIS Cancer Foundation Annual Charity Ball. All artists are

invited to submit their work for raising funds for CRIS Cancer Foundation projects. Artists will generously donate their artworks for the Silent Auction. (If they are not sold on the night, they can collect them afterwards from CRIS Cancer Foundation office). There are no restrictions of age or country of origin. All submissions will be considered by Gloria Ceballos (Responsible of CRIS Cancer Foundation's Art Department) for final show during the night and inclusion on the catalogue.

ELIGIBILITY & TERMS

Artists working in all medium are welcome to apply except installations, video and new media.

All artwork submitted must be ready to hang or install.

Works on paper must be framed: Photographs, drawings and prints must be framed.

Artists living outside London are also welcome to apply, however you will be responsible for artwork shipping costs.

Artists may submit online up to 5 works. Please don't submit original artworks at this stage. If you are selected, you will be contacted to deliver your work.

Original artwork will be included in the 6th Charity Ball night and catalogue. It will be viewed by nearly 600 potential buyers on the night plus more through the catalogue and social media. 100% of the proceeds will be donated to the CRIS Cancer Foundation.

Submission Deadline: September 15th, 2017

HOW TO APPLY

Applications should be sent via mail to Gloria Ceballos: qceballos@criscancer.org

Every eligible application must contain the following, as separate documents:

- An artist resume/CV including name, address, telephone number, email, and short bio (max. 2 pages); titled 'LastName FirstName CV'
- Artist statement (max. 150 words); titled 'LastName_FirstName_Artist Statement' that will be included in the final catalogue below the photograph of your artwork.

- Visual artists: submit up to 10 images of recent work. Do not send actual artwork pieces. Please label your artwork with the "title" and your name; for example, "TitleofArt_JennaSmith".No files bigger than 10 MB for consideration.
- For each artwork submitted please include the following information: Artist name, Title, Media, Year, Dimensions, Weight (for sculptures). In the case of editions (prints, photographs...) please include print number and edition number.
- One HR photograph of each submitted artwork. These will be used in the catalogue if you are selected.

DELIVERY OF ACCEPTED WORK:

If you are selected, you will be asked to deliver your artwork between October 2nd through 20th, 2017. Shipping address is CRIS Cancer Foundation, Basement 43 Sussex St. SW1V 4RJ. Opening hours: Monday to Friday 9am -17pm. The artist assumes all responsibility for insuring artwork against shipping damage or loss. Artists will be responsible for delivery and return shipping of all their artwork. All work must be gallery ready for installation.
