
- → CRIS contra el Cancer is a private, independent, non-profit foundation.







Maternity/paternity

How can affect the maternity/paternity to the Res.Independence / PhD date requirement?

Date of Research Independence (Excellence) or PhD (Em.Leader, Tr.Physician, Out-Back) will be extended by 1 year per child in the case of male researchers, and 3 years per child in the case of female researchers. These periods are also extended in the case of non-born children.

What documents can be submitted to prove maternity / paternity?

Any official document that accredits the mother/father-child relationship: family book, birth certificate, maternity/paternity leave, child's passport...



economic audit report (external)

→ Midterm evaluation: "The programme runs initially for three years and may be renewed for a further two years up to a maximum of five years, provided that the progress reports requested annually, and the midterm evaluation carried out after the second year are favourable."



Is there any requirement related to the current labour contract of the candidate?

- → There is no requirement or restriction related to the labour contract of the applicant during the submission and evaluation processes. However, it is mandatory to have the commitment of the hosting institution signed.
- → In case of being awarded, the agreement will be signed with the hosting institution, so the applicant/awardee must have a labour contract with the hosting institution.

Is it mandatory to be PI of a research group to apply?

- → It is not compulsory in any of the calls.
- → In calls for more senior profiles, it will be positively valued.

Is it possible for one candidate to apply to several Programmes?

- → A candidate may not apply to several CRIS Research Programmes (Excellence, Em.Leader, Tr.Physician).
- → A candidate may apply to several calls for applications that are compatible with each other. For example, there is not incompatibility between CRIS Tr.Physician and Real-Life Trials in Oncology Programmes.
- → calls for applications for one candidate to apply to several Programmes?

Is it possible to apply several Co-PI to one candidacy?

- → It is not allowed to submit an application with two applicants (PI and Co-IP).
- → The grant is allocated to a specific applicant. However, collaborations may appear, which may be specified in the project. If they complement the application, they will be positively valued. The collaborator may be a mentor.

What happens if the candidate does not need the to cover his/her salary?

- → It is not mandatory to use the funds to pay the salary.
- → The salary can be covered by the institution or any other funding source. However, the budget must indicate the source of financing the salary of the applicant.

Can the salary be supplemented?

- → If the applicant has his/her salary covered, the funds can used for:
 - Supplementing the salary, up to the maximum attributable to salary in each call
 - Project costs

Is there any requirement for the host institution?

- → The Hosting Institution must be allocated in Spain (Excellence, Em.Leader, Tr.Physiscian, Out-back_Return)
- → The Hosting Institution must have the capacity to recruit the applicant
- → The Hosting Institution may be linked to another institution (For example, IBIMA and Hospital Universitario Virgen de la Victoria de Málaga), and the applicant may be developing the Project between both institutions.

Is there any requirement for the mentor?

- → If the applicant is hierarchically dependent on another researcher, the mentor fits with the idea of supervisor. The mentor must be the researcher to whom the applicant is hierarchically dependent, as the mentor must guarantee certain resources to the applicant, and the authorship of publications deriving from the project linked to the submission.
- → If the applicant is not hierarchically dependent on another researcher, the mentor does not consist of a supervisor or a person who is necessarily involved in the day-to-day running of the Project. In this case, the mentor it is more of a reference figure, with whom a fluid relationship is maintained, who can give feedback, guidance or suggestions at any given time, both in purely scientific matters and even in career counselling. So, the mentor can work in the same institution or in a different one from the applicant's, even in an institution outside Spain.

Can several proposals have the same mentor?

→ One researcher can be mentor of several proposals, there is no restriction in this respect.

How to integrate Gender Dimension in the Research project template

→ Gender Dimension must be integrated in the Research project template at the level of project design, taking into account gender differences, and at the level of equity/parity in the research group's personnel.

What does the "Lay Summary" document consist of?

- → The Lay Summary is a document that should explaining the project in a simple way, understandable to patients.
- → The document should include the explanation in English (one page) and in Spanish (one page)

- → CRIS Emerging Leader: what documents can be submitted to prove having worked at least 12 months abroad?
- → Any official document proving the stay: rent, employment contract, document signed by supervisor or institution...

CRIS Excellence: what documents can be submitted to prove Research Independence?

→ Any official document proving independence: being a beneficiary of a project, a letter from the centre...
